

SigEp Minimum Eligibility Standards

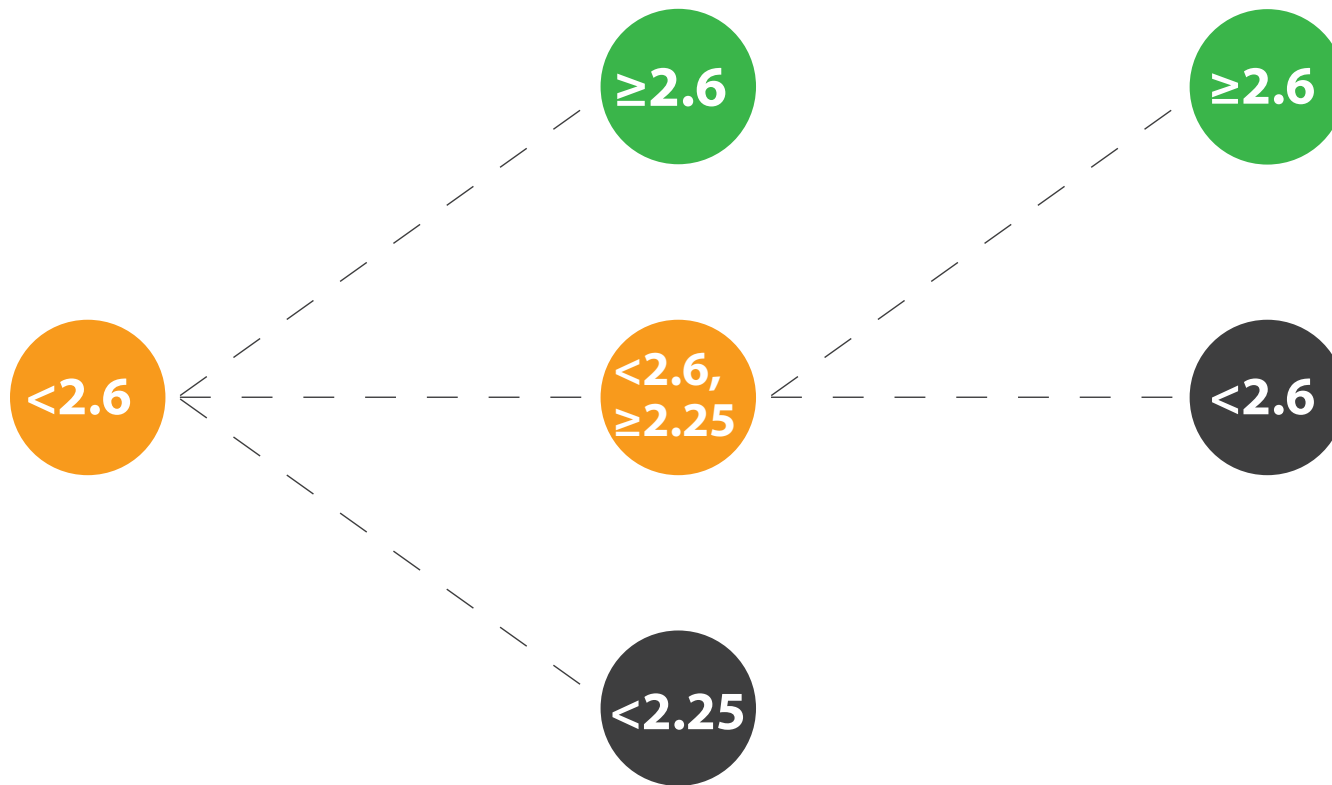
According to Article II of the Grand Chapter Bylaws, as modified at the 53rd Grand Chapter Conclave

- Member is in good standing* (must also be financially current)
- Member is restricted**
- Member is automatically expelled***

New Member Eligibility

To be eligible for membership, a candidate must have a cumulative GPA of ≥ 2.7 from high school, or ≥ 2.6 from college.

Officer Eligibility

Chapter officers must maintain a cumulative GPA of ≥ 2.8 or the chapter's minimum (whichever is higher) throughout their term.

Financial Obligation

To remain in good standing, a member must also be current on all financial obligations to his chapter, his AVC, and the Fraternity.

* Nothing shall prohibit a chapter from setting a higher minimum GPA standard or a shorter timeline for suspension and expulsion for academics (Article II, Section 6 (a)).

** Restricted members may not vote, serve as chapter officers, or serve as committee chairmen. Members must also seek help to improve their grades (Article II, Section 6 (h)).

*** Automatically expelled members do not have the right to appeal, but may be reinstated if they attain a cumulative and term GPA of ≥ 2.6 (Article II, Section 6 (g)).
