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

Prepare


- Research Company
- Ask Questions...
 - Format, types of questions, setting interviewers, length, process
- Get Familiar w/ Job Description
- Pre-Interview Exercise
- Dress to Impress



Kill the A.N.T.s:

- Automatic Negative Thoughts
 - Write them down
 - Assess
 - Talk Back to Them

- Practice and Role Play
 - "Tell me about yourself"
 - "Why are you a good fit?"
 - "Why do you want this role?"

Breathing

- In for 4, Out for 4
- Anxiety = Excitement
- Find a Friend





Execute

- Ask Questions
 - Specific and Impactful
 - Develop conversation
 - Write them down
 - Prepare a closing statement
- Video/Phone Interviews
 - Dress the same
 - Test technology
 - Set up in right environment





Follow-Up

- Thank You notes to all parties
- Letter or Note
- Same Day If Possible
 - Express Excitement
 - Be Specific
 - Express Gratitude
 - Reinforce Qualifications
 - Address any Concerns






- How to Fail
