RESOLVED

That the Ritual Task Force will both address the findings and recommendations outlined in the aforementioned report and honor the historical origins, writings, and experiences expressed in prior ritual guides and ceremonies; and be it

RESOLVED

Undergraduate and alumni members of the Fraternity will be provided with multiple opportunities between 2021 and 2023 to provide input and feedback on draft revisions, such as reviewing and observing the draft revisions at Carlson Leadership Academy; and be it

RESOLVED

The Ritual Task Force will provide quarterly updates to the National Board of Directors on the Task Force's efforts to revise the Ritual; and be it

RESOLVED

That unless and until the 2023 Grand Chapter approves the revised *Ritual and Guide of Sigma Phi Epsilon*, chapters of Sigma Phi Epsilon will continue to perform current ritual practices,

subject to any interim adjustments or guidance the Grand Chapter or National Board of Directors has or hereafter may approve; and be it

The Ritual Task Force make every effort to complete this effort in time to present the revised *Ritual and Guide of Sigma Phi Epsilon* to the 58th Grand Chapter Conclave for its consideration.
