

SIGEP SOCIAL DISTANCING AND BED POSITIONING GUIDE

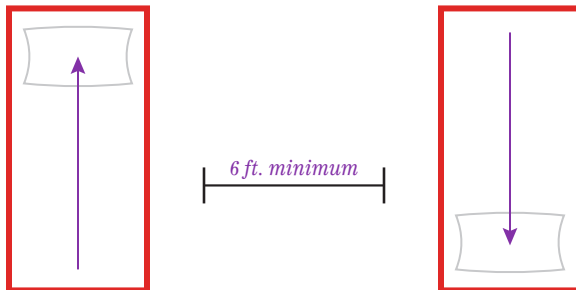
NOTES

Social Distancing involves establishing ways to increase physical distance between individuals in settings where people commonly come into close contact with one another.

To ensure the safety of members in a residential setting and reduce the spread of COVID-19 transmission, below are instructions for bed positioning on all open sides of bed.

SINGLE BEDS POSITIONED NEXT TO EACH OTHER (SIDE-TO-SIDE):

At least 6 feet apart AND members' laying position is *head to toe*.



BEDS POSITIONED ACROSS FROM ONE ANOTHER (END-TO-END):

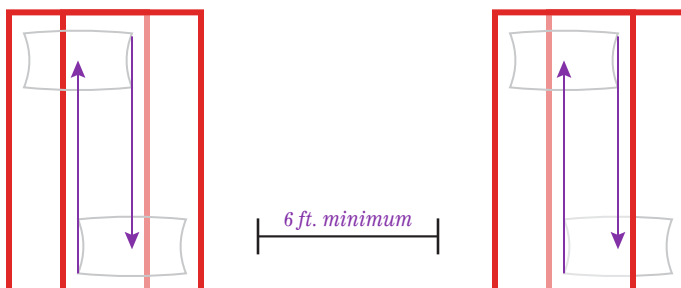
Feet of beds are at least 6 feet apart AND members' laying position is *toe to toe*.



BUNKBEDS THAT ARE POSITIONED NEXT TO EACH OTHER OR ACROSS FROM ONE ANOTHER:

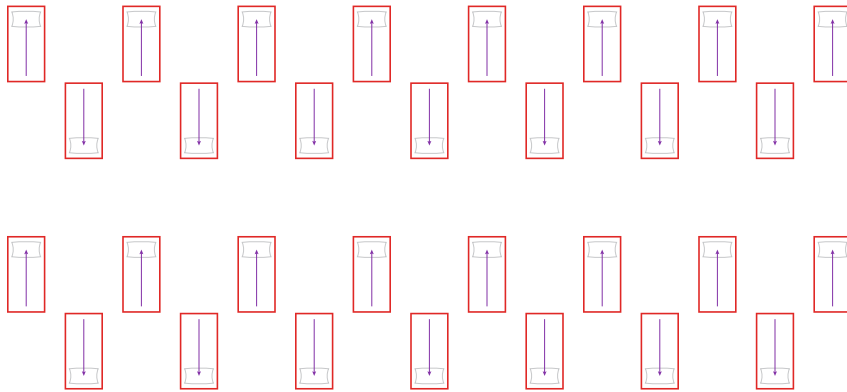
Position beds at least 6 feet apart.

Ensure members' laying position is *head to toe* on each separate bunk bed, so positioning allows for the least transmission risk as possible. This includes laying position that is *head to toe* with adjacent bunks.



COLD DORMS:

When multiple beds are positioned in a large-ventilated room, arrange bunk in a staggered arrangement providing at least six feet between beds, and alternate head and foot positions on adjacent bunks.



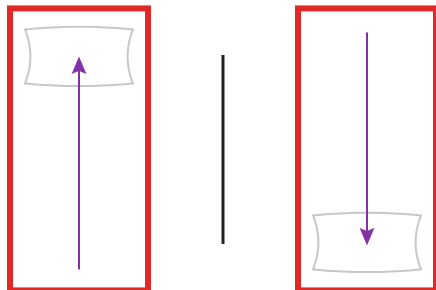
PLACEMENT WHEN POSITIONING BEDS 6 FEET OR MORE IS NOT POSSIBLE:

SINGLE BEDS:

Position beds at least 3 feet apart.

Consider placing partitions (e.g., nailing string from wall-to-wall and hanging sheets or blanket, using dressers or cardboard boxes as a barrier, etc) between beds.

Ensure members' laying position is *head to toe*.



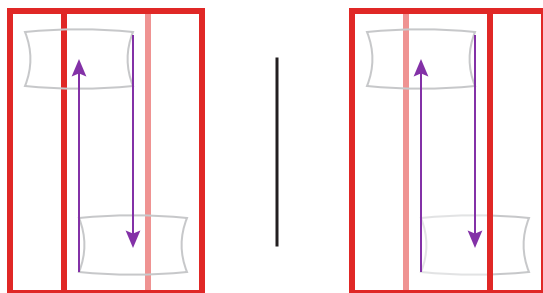
when less than 6 ft. min.

BUNKBEDS:

Position beds at least 3 feet apart.

Consider placing partitions (e.g., nailing string from wall-to-wall and hanging sheets or blanket, using dressers or cardboard boxes as a barrier, etc) between beds.

Ensure the members' laying position is *head to toe* on each separate bunk bed, including positioned *head to toe* on adjacent bunks.
